Thank you immensely for joining us in this meaningful effort to uplift and encourage our students. Your participating is truly appreciated.

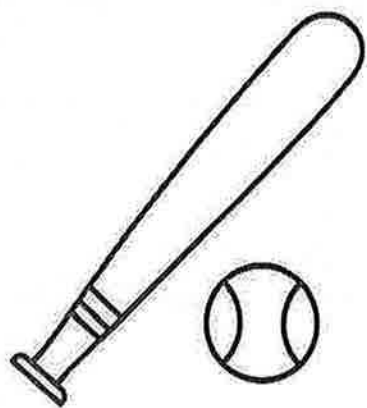

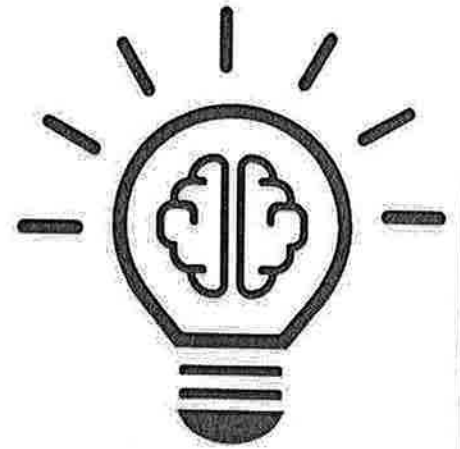

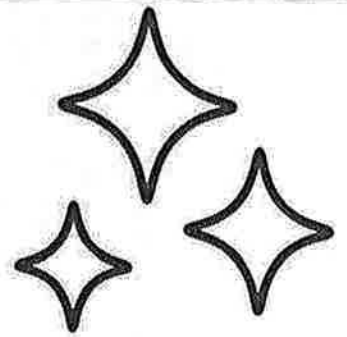
